All such people will doubtless go to their just reward, and only discover their mistake when it is too late.

**S**ome people think that there is a God, but he is so good (according to their idea of goodness) that he will not punish anybody. If a government did not punish criminals, would there be any peace or safety? How much more a holy, righteous God must punish sin. The Holy Bible explains this to us.

**It is appointed unto men once to die,  
but after this the judgment. (Heb 9:27)**

**M**any people have made for themselves various religions of their own. Some of these religions teach their followers to love humanity while others promote the worship of spirits, placating devils and using horoscopes. In addition to these, new religions constantly spring up around power-hungry preachers. Does any religion give you the assurance of sins forgiven? ### **Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. ( 1 Timothy 1:15)**
